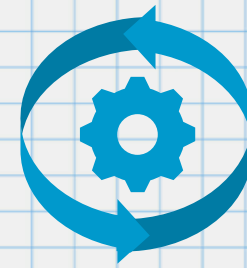

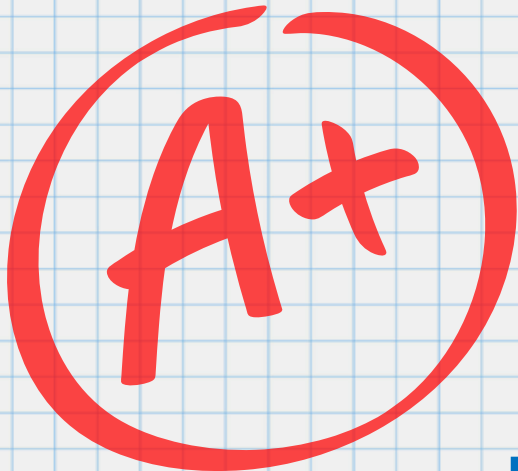

- Health Records
- Student Financial Information
- Grades and Reports
- Class Lists and Course Schedules
- Testing Records



STUDENT RECORDS

- Must have appropriate Retention/Access Policies
 - Compliance with both State and Federal
- Many that are older are still in paper form
 - And included in archival storage
- Newer records come from external sources and must be associated to the student record
 - State Tests, Medical/Counseling, etc.



STUDENT RECORDS

- Easy Digitization
- Automatic Document Classification
- Intelligent Data Extraction
- Applying appropriate metadata to ECM
- Ultra High Compression



ENDOWMENT / ALUMNI

- Alumni Records
- Donations /Checks
- Fundraising Campaigns
- Financial Statements
- Property Management
- Grant or Dedicated Donations



ENDOWMENT / ALUMNI

- Storing, tracking and tracing transactions from alumni & donors
- Prepare check batches for deposit
- Protecting donor information
- Record financial transactions:
interest, deposits, withdrawals, etc.
- Associate spending and tracking of grants



ENDOWMENT / ALUMNI

- We have worked with multiple universities who ultimately chose to use IRIS to read
- Information from checks and then redact account information before storing the information
- Captured and sort multiple transaction types with diverse layouts from many institutions
- Classify & associate other related documents

REGISTRAR OFFICE

- Manual processes around data entry and validation of student information
